



JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ Nexus Funding Facility (NFF) Board Meeting

Yaounde, Cameroon – 6 May 2026

The NFF Board convened on 6 May 2026 in Yaoundé, Cameroon, under the co-chairmanship of the Resident and Humanitarian Coordinator for Cameroon and the Executive Secretary of the Lake Chad Basin Commission (represented by the LCBC Technical Director). The Board endorsed the first NFF allocation and key governance decisions, while setting the strategic direction for the next Nigeria allocation cycle.

1. First Allocation

Acting on the recommendations of the Independent Technical Review Committee (ITRC), the Board endorsed two consortia under the first allocation, subject to agreed preconditions and risk mitigation measures prior to contracting: As-Sabour ("Resilience"), led by CRS, in Hadjer Lamis Province, Chad; and JASIR ("Joint Action for Stabilization, Inclusion and Resilience"), led by CBM, in the Far North Region of Cameroon.

2. Next Allocation Cycle

The Board approved Nigeria as the focus of the next allocation and endorsed the geographic and thematic priorities identified through consultations with national stakeholders. Relevant cross-border dimensions will be strongly encouraged under the call for proposals.

3. Governance

The Board established a Governance Working Group to develop recommendations on the NFF's governance arrangements, including institutional representation, accountability and decision-making modalities.

4. Partnerships

The Board welcomed ongoing efforts to strengthen partnerships and resource mobilization in support of the NFF.
